Devotional Reading

October 7 - October 13

This week, we'll consider what David said about how he valued the Word of God in Psalm 119. As you read, prayerfully consider how the thoughts of the psalmist are present in your own life. Consider your journey with God to this point and engage with the reflection questions for each passage.

Sunday, October 7: Psalm 119:9-10

* Verse 10 says, "with all my heart I have sought You...."

How does that resonate with your current season with God?

* Consider the things you have on your calendar tomorrow. How would they look differently if your priority was seeking God in such a wholehearted way?

Monday, October 8: Psalm 119:11

* What does it look like to treasure something in your heart?

* Recall a time in your life when God's Word was especially important to you. What about that time made God's Word so important? How did meditating on it impact you?

Tuesday, October 9: Psalm 119:49-50

* What promises in God's Word do you hold most dear? Why?

* How does it impact you to realize that God desires to comfort you and offer you hope through His Word? Can you think of a time when you would agree with David's words?

Wednesday, October 10: Psalm 119:65-67

* David begins this section reflecting on God's favor in dealing with him. How do you see God's history of dealing favorably with you? What episodes leap to your mind as examples?

* When you have rebelled, how has God gotten your attention? How does He demonstrate His love for you, even in those seasons?

Thursday, October 11: Psalm 119:74

* How does the evidence of godliness in others affect your desire to spend time with them? Does it make you glad to be with them?

* To what degree would you say that this is true of you?

Friday, October 12: Psalm 119: 105-106

* Perhaps these verses are familiar to you. What does it mean for God's Word to be a lamp to your feet and a light to your path? How regularly do you engage God's Word for wisdom and guidance in your own life?

* What commitment have you made to keep His Word in your own life? Do think that is important?

Saturday, October 13: Psalm 119:173-176

* How do you most need God to help you this week?

Based on what you've read this week, how confident are you in His action on your behalf?

* When you wander, how does it make you feel to know that God loves you and pursues you?
